- Offered adapted Summer Programs (with reduced participant numbers);
- Piloted new After School Programs to help get students outside;
- Offered virtual teacher professional development workshops.

- Developed a 'virtual' 35th Clambake with an online auction and take-out meals at The Back Eddy & Greasy Luck;
- Maintains our five miles of hiking trails so that visitors can enjoy getting "back to nature" during this difficult time.
